## Driving Directions to Texas Tin Roof Cabin



**From the North (Dallas, Ft Worth, via I-35):** Just south of the convergence of I 35E and I-35W you will exit Hillsboro (exit #370). Go right at the stop sign (spur 579.) Take spur 579 into Hillsboro and turn right just past the courthouse on Elm/22 West. exit 370 for Hillsboro. Exit and head right (west) on Hwy 77 into downtown Hillsboro. Turn right at the second light in the town square (Hwy 22 going west) just past the courthouse. Once you are on Hwy 22 heading west to Whitney follow the directions from highway 22 listed below.

**From the south (San Antonio, Austin) via I-35:** From I-35 north take exit 368A and follow the signs for Hwy 22 west through Hillsboro (left on hwy 22, right on hwy 77, left on hwy 22 again.) Once you are on Hwy 22 heading west to Whitney follow the directions below.

### **From Hwy 22:**

Take 22 West into Whitney. Just after the Radioshack on the right hand side the road will veer to the right onto spur 180. Take spur 180 to the stop light at Brazos/FM 933. Turn right. Take 933 past Dollar General, Brookshire's, and Whitney High School all the way to the flashing light at the Lamp Post corner store. Turn left onto FM1713 (at the flashing light.) After about 3.5 miles 1713 will veer to the right. (Don't take spur 1713 that goes straight.) Take 1713 over the bridge and all the way to hwy 56. Take a left on 56 and go 2 miles until you get to CR1523. Turn left on CR1523 into the Canyons neighborhood entrance. At the first intersection go left on CR1500. Turn left at the first street which is CR 1514 and the Tin Roof Cabin will be the at the end of the street on the left just past the Hacienda house. It's #147.

### **Neighborhood Cove**

Take 1500 back towards the neighborhood entrance (you don't leave the neighborhood). Turn left on 1523 (at the intersection near the newspaper machines). Turn left on 1526. Turn left on 1540. Follow 1540 all the way to the cove (it's kind of a winding paved road that turns into a gravel road).

**CAUTION! Please drive slowly and carefully through the neighborhood. There are residents walking their dogs, as well as deer and other wildlife living in this area. Please help keep everyone safe!**
